**127,000 employee judgments influenced the survey conducted by FOCUS and kununu**

### **ebm-papst among 1000 best Employers**

**In 2018, ebm-papst was once again awarded as one of the best employers in Germany. This was confirmed by a survey conducted by the news magazine FOCUS in cooperation with kununu. de, the employer evaluation portal for employees, apprentices and applicants. The survey is one of the largest of its kind.**

Of the 1000 companies evaluated, ebm-papst ranked 146th overall (previous year: 147th place). In the mechanical engineering and plant construction sector, ebm-papst achieved a stable 12th place (previous year: 11th), and ebm-papst jumped to 14th place in the electronics and electrical engineering sector.

Stefan Brandl, CEO of the ebm-papst Group, emphasizes: "We are very pleased with this good result. It shows that we have a good corporate climate and that people feel comfortable at ebm-papst. We want to continue working on that."

For the sixth time, Focus magazine in cooperation with kununu has chosen the 1000 best employers in Germany. The market research institute Statista evaluated more than 127,000 employer assessments based on an independent online survey, a survey among XING members and current Kununu data.

Employees and workers from all levels of hierarchy and age groups could participate. Among other things, respondents stated how satisfied they are with their manager's leadership, career prospects, salary and the employer's work-life balance. It was also crucial whether the employees would recommend their employer to others.
